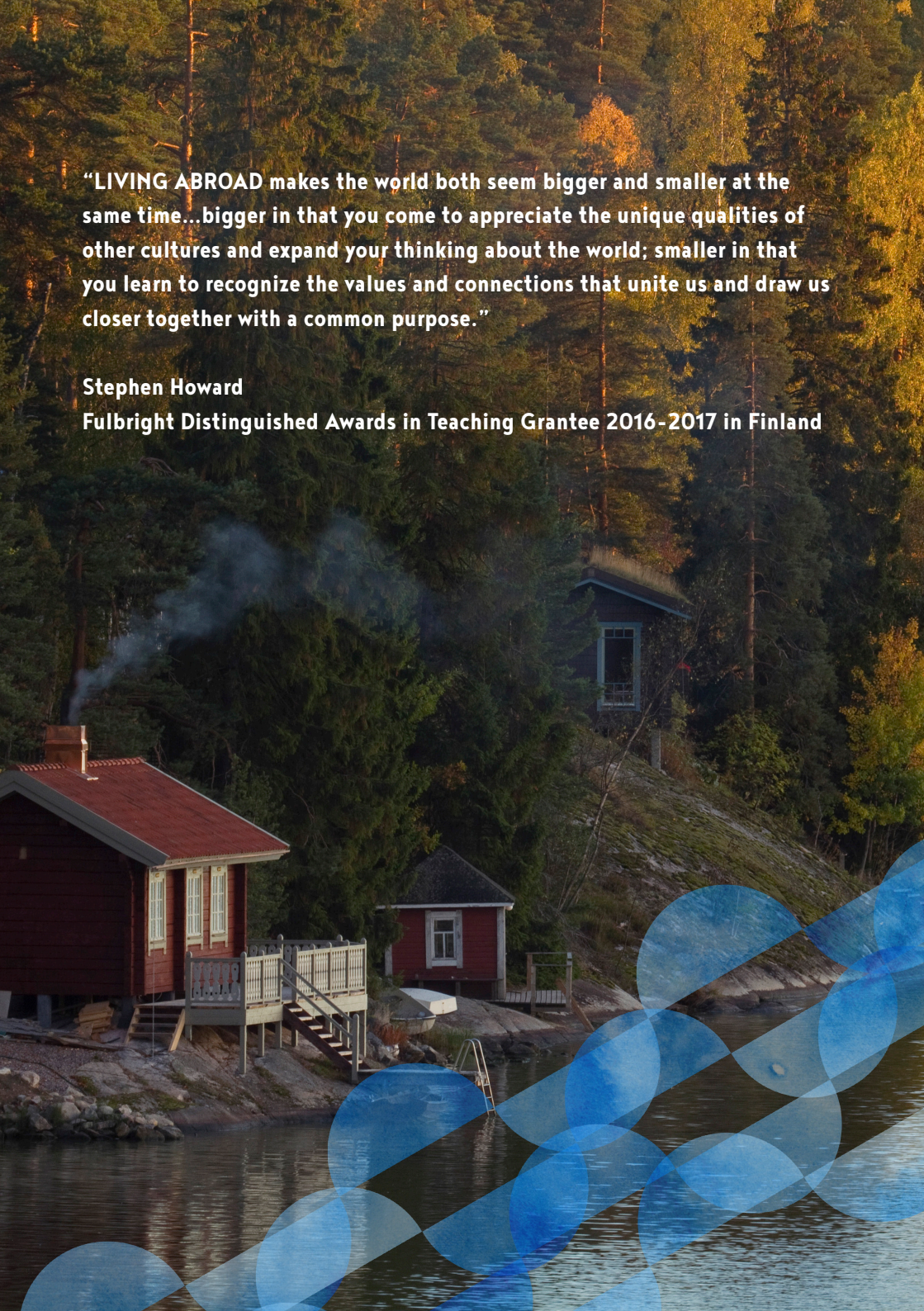

Orientation Speakers

In addition to the Fulbright Finland team and alumni experts, we are pleased to include the following speakers in the 2019 orientation program for the U.S. grantees.



Robert Frank Pence is the U.S. Ambassador to the Republic of Finland. Previously, he served as the founder and Chairman of the Board of the Pence Group, a full-service development company. He was also active as a board member of the Gary Sinise Foundation and served on the boards of the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, the Wolf Trap Foundation, the World Affairs Council, George Mason University, and American University. He is Honorary Chair of the Fulbright Finland Foundation Board of Directors.



Jouni Ahonen is the Commercial Director and Vice President in Haaga-Helia University of Applied Sciences and a board member of Hotel Haaga Ltd. and chairman of the board of EduExcellence Ltd. His expertise is in the field of services marketing. He has served in several managerial positions in the hospitality and tourism industry. For 13 years, he was a head of hospitality and tourism management programs at Haaga Hospitality Campus.



William Couch is the Public Affairs Officer at the U.S. Embassy in Helsinki. This is his first posting in Europe; he previously served in China (three tours) and Barbados. Prior to joining the Foreign Service in 2006, Bill was an educator teaching Social Sciences grades 7 through 12 and Geography at the university level. He has a B.S. in Secondary Education from the University of North Alabama and a M.S. in Geography from the University of Alabama. Bill is married to Laura and has a nine-year-old son, Elijah.



Ilkka Haavisto is Research Manager at Finnish Business and Policy Forum EVA. He has worked with a wide range of economic and social issues including public sector reform, taxation, labour market and the EU. He graduated from Åbo Akademi University (economics and philosophy) in 2000.



Pekka Haavisto is the Minister for Foreign Affairs at Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland, Member of Finnish Parliament (1987-1995, 2007-) and the Green Party chair. Haavisto was the first green minister in Europe, as a Minister for Environment and Development in Lipponen's first government (1995-1999). He has also recently served as a Minister for Development and State Ownership in Katainen-Stubb government (2013-2014).



Johanna Hakala Ph.D. is the Manager of International Affairs at the Academy of Finland and alumna of the Fulbright mid-career professional development (MCPD) program. She is responsible for the overall coordination of the Academy's activities supporting international research collaboration and mobility. She has previously worked in university research administration and as a researcher in the field of science studies.



Erja Heikkinen has been with the Ministry of Education and Culture in Finland since 2005. Her tasks consist of national and international science policy responsibilities. An essential part of her work takes place in national and multinational networks. Dr. Heikkinen is heading the Science Policy Division of the Department of Higher Education and Science Policy.



Birger Holm currently works as a Vice Principal, History and Civics Teacher at Haukilahti School in Espoo. He is the U.S. State Department's Voluntary Visitor Program alumnus and has promoted interdisciplinary studies in Finland by inspiring English teachers to introduce more U.S. History content in English classes.



Timo Korkeamäki is the Professor of Finance at the Hanken School of Economics in Helsinki. He received his PhD in 2001 from University of South Carolina. Prior to joining Hanken in 2008, he taught at Gonzaga University in Spokane, WA for seven years. Timo is a member of the Fulbright Finland Foundation Board of Directors.



Johanna Lahti is a sauna advocate and a member of the Finnish Sauna Society, a cultural association fostering the heritage of the national bath. She bathes several times a week and enjoys all kinds of saunas from public saunas to her own city apartment sauna. Johanna is a staff alumna of the Fulbright Finland Foundation.



Pirita Näkkäläjärvi is a vocal advocate for Sámi culture and rights and her expert analysis is regularly sought by Finnish media on those subjects. Pirita currently works as a mergers & acquisitions advisor at PwC and previously she ran the Sámi-language operations of the Finnish Broadcasting Company Yle. She holds MSc Economics (Aalto) and MSc Media & Communications with Distinction (London School of Economics). Pirita was named the Sámi of the Year in Finland in 2017.



Paula Parviainen has served as Ambassador at the Embassy of Finland in Singapore and as Deputy Head of Mission at the Embassy in Beijing. Her career in the Diplomatic Service includes also posts at Finland's Permanent Mission to the UN and the Embassy in Paris. In the Ministry, Parviainen has worked at the Department for External Economic Relations, the Protocol Department and the Unit for Asia and Oceania. She has also served as Press Attaché to the Minister for Foreign Trade.



Elisa Repo is a doctoral student in applied linguistics at the Johannes Gutenberg University of Mainz and at the University of Turku. Currently she is working as a teacher for linguistically and culturally responsive teaching at the Department of Teacher Education at the University of Turku. She has been a visiting research fellow at the Finnish Institute in Germany, visiting scholar at the University of Hamburg, Germany, and as a Fulbright FLTA at Indiana University, IN, USA.



Karen Spens is the Rector of Hanken since 2015 and she will hold office for a term of five years, until 2020. She is Professor of Supply Chain Management and Corporate Geography at Hanken. Her research has mainly focused on humanitarian logistics in which she has published several books, co-founded the Journal of Humanitarian Logistics and Supply Chain Management as well as the Humanitarian Logistics and Supply Chain Research Institute (HUMLOG Institute).



Jukka Tanskanen is a science adviser at Academy of Finland and the manager of the Academy's collaborative activities with the National Science Foundation (NSF). He received a Ph.D. in chemistry from the University of Eastern Finland. He was a materials physicist at Posiva, an expert organization in nuclear waste management, and a postdoctoral fellow at Stanford University before moving to Academy of Finland in 2014. He supports science policy-making in particular in the fields of chemistry, physics and materials science, and manages several collaborative programs both between Finland and the EU countries and between Finland and the NSF.

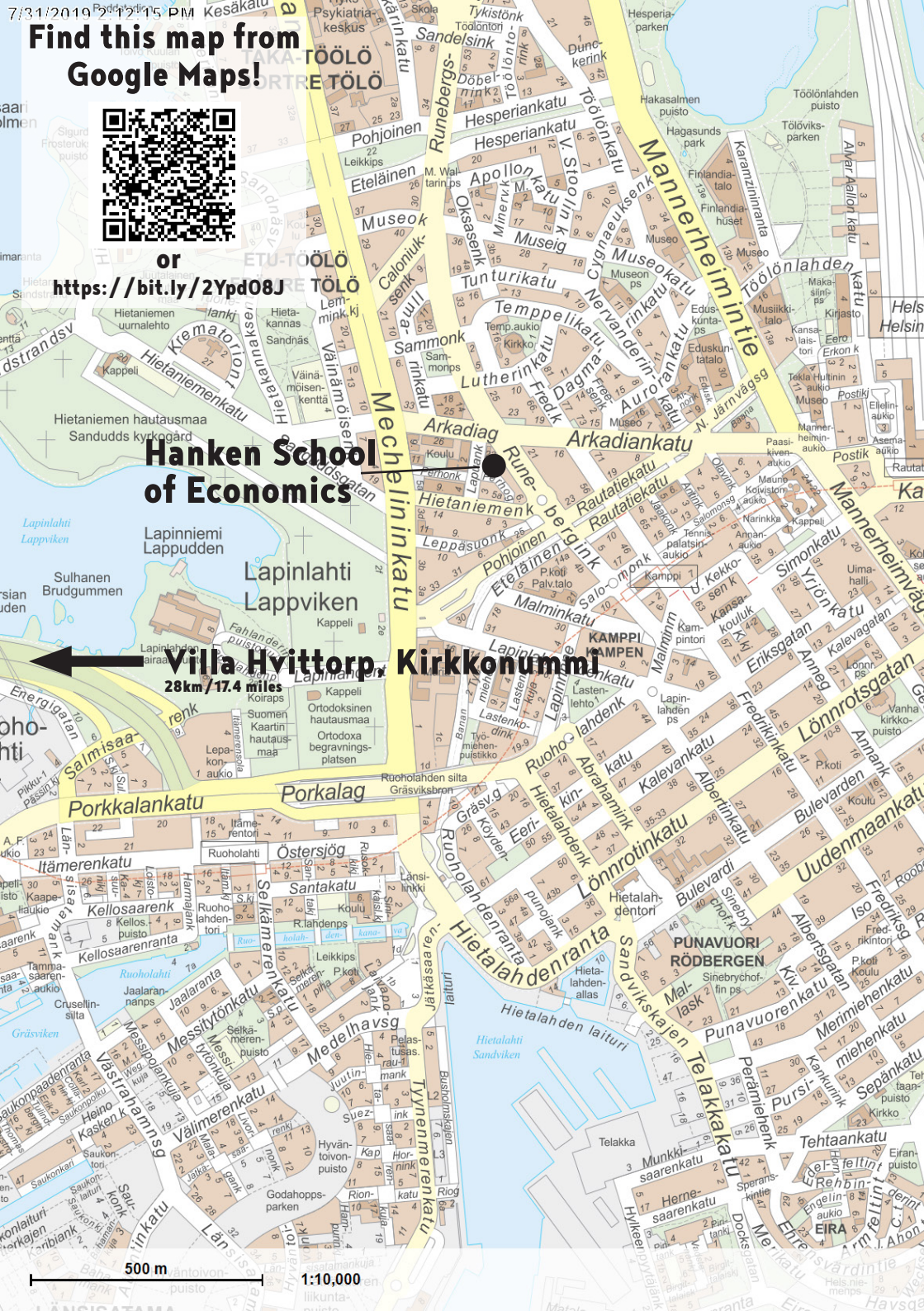

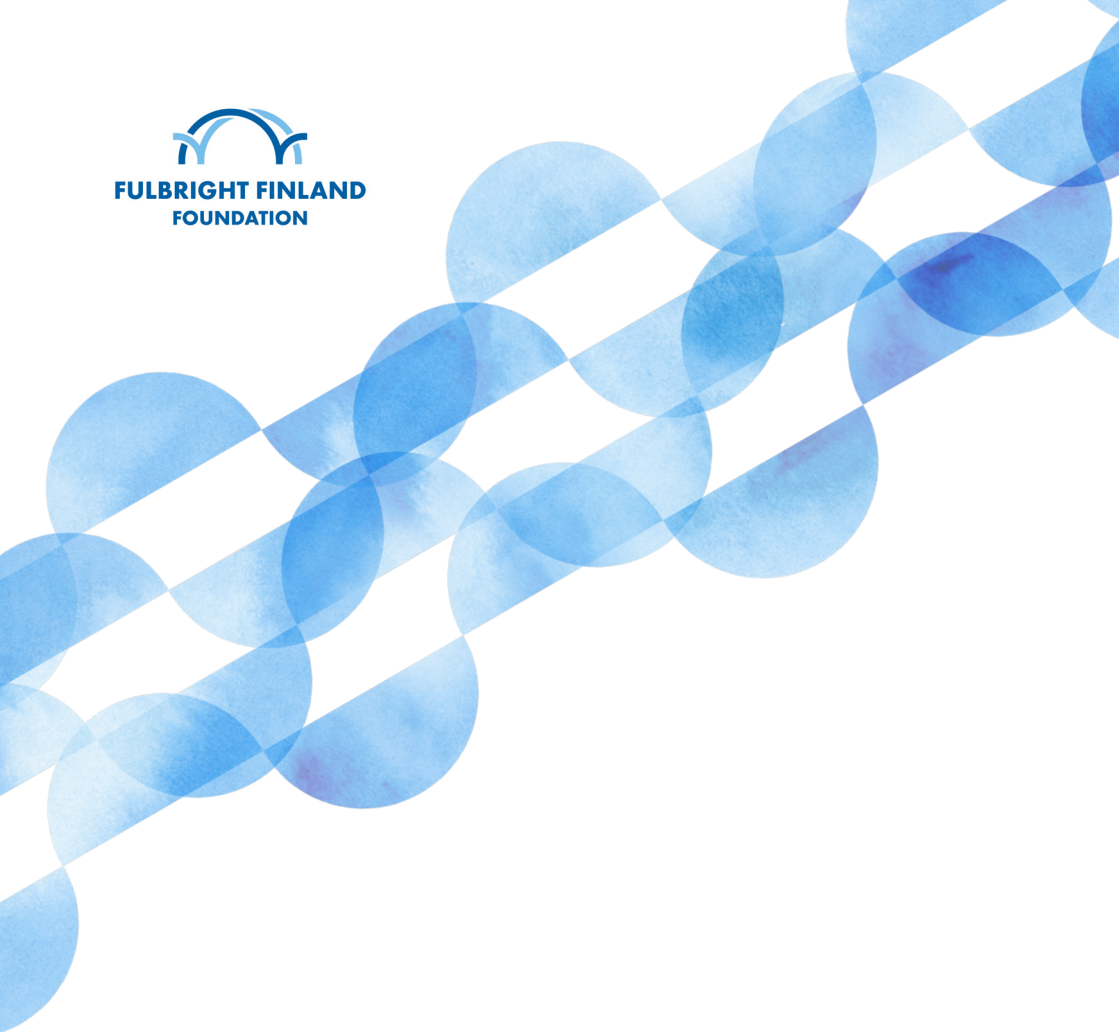
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
