Fulbright Finland Foundation

The Fulbright Finland Foundation is an independent not-for-profit organization based in Helsinki, Finland. Its purpose is to promote a wider exchange of knowledge and professional talents through educational contacts between Finland and the United States. The Foundation collaborates with a range of government, foundation, university, and corporate partners on both sides of the Atlantic to design and manage study and research scholarships, leadership development programs, and internationalization services.

The Foundation supports the internationalization of education and research in Finland and helps U.S. and Finnish institutions create linkages. Under its Internationalization Services, the Foundation organizes themed study tours to the U.S. for Finnish higher education experts, runs the highly popular Fulbright Speaker Program, the Fulbright Dialogues series, and the Transatlantic Roundtables, as well as organizes two national Fulbright Seminars every year.

The Foundation is funded by the Finnish Ministry of Education and Culture, the U.S. Department of State, the Finland-America Educational Trust Fund, private foundations, Finnish and U.S. higher education institutions, alumni of the Fulbright Finland Foundation programs, and private donors. Over 70% of the Foundation's core funding originates from Finland, and advancement, fundraising and sponsored grants are a central part of the operation.

A key strength of the Fulbright Finland Foundation is the consistent strategic engagement of the alumni. Since 1949, over 6 200 students, scholars, teachers, artists, and professionals have participated in our exchange programs – over 4 000 from Finland and over 2 200 from the U.S. Representing all fields in the arts, sciences, and society at large, grantees and alumni are vital to the Foundation's vision: empowering minds to find global solutions to tomorrow's challenges.

The Board of Directors of the Fulbright Finland Foundation consists of eight members appointed by the Finnish Ministry of Education and the U.S. Embassy in Finland. The U.S. Ambassador to Finland serves as the Honorary Chair of the Board.

The Fulbright Finland Foundation awards grants to nearly 100 students, scholars, and professionals annually. This year, approximately 40 grantees participate in the Fulbright Finland Foundation programs to the U.S. 36 of them are featured in this catalog, and they have received a grant to lecture, conduct research, study, or teach in the U.S. In this catalog, you can also find the Fulbright Finland Travel Grant awardee and Study of the U.S. Institute program grantees, who had their programs during the summer of 2024.

FULBRIGHT PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

My project focuses on Indigenous conceptualization of biodiversity and onto-epistemic structures in halting biodiversity loss. UN SDGs note that biodiversity is the basis for climate-change risk reduction, resilience, and thus the future of the planet. Yet, moving beyond a universalist approach, this interdisciplinary project will offer an evidence-based, in-depth, long-term analysis of local experiences of biodiversity. It co-examines how Amazonian Indigenous notions of time relate to their conceptualisation of environmental diversity and their land uses.
